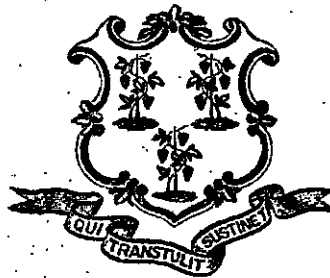

CHAPTER 110.

An Act concerning Aiding the Escape of Insane Patients.

1907 Ch. 29.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:*

Every person who shall aid or abet, or who shall conspire with another to aid or abet, the escape from any hospital or sanitarium of any person committed to such hospital or sanitarium as insane, shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars, or imprisoned not more than two years, or both.

Penalty for aiding or abetting escape of insane person from hospital or sanitarium.

Approved, July 6, 1905.

CHAPTER 111.

An Act concerning Discrimination on Account of Alienage, Race, or Color.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:*

Every person who, on account of alienage, race, or color, shall subject or cause to be subjected any other person to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immunities secured or protected by the constitution or laws of this state, or who, on that account, shall deprive any other person from the full and equal enjoyment of the advantages, facilities, accommodations, or privileges of any place of public accommodation, amusement, or transportation, subject only to the limitations established by law and applicable alike to all persons, or who, on that account, shall discriminate in the price for the enjoyment of such privileges, shall forfeit and pay to the person injured thereby double damages, to be recovered in any court of competent jurisdiction within this state.

Discrimination on account of alienage, race, or color prohibited.

Approved, June 6, 1905.
